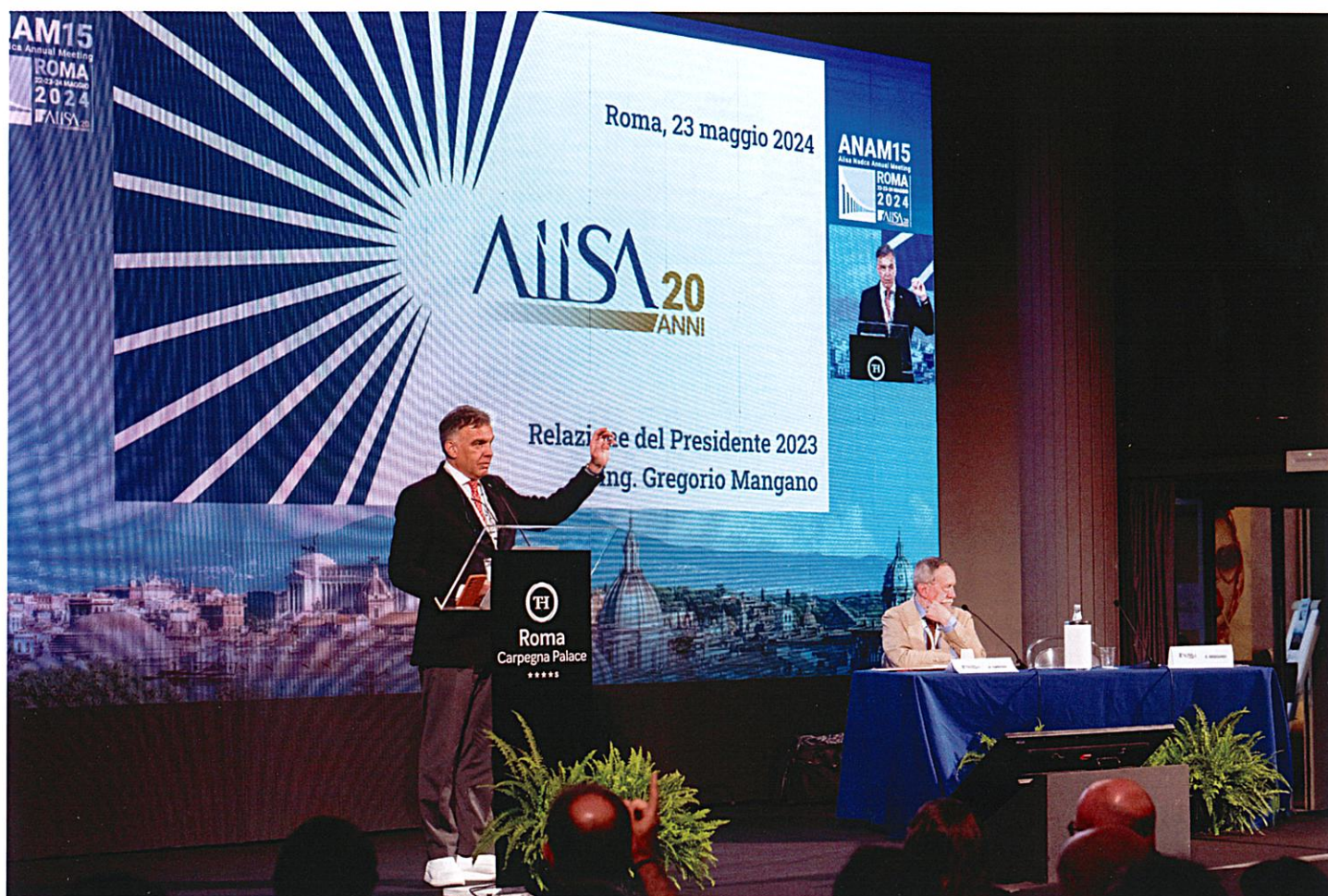

Good quality of air in hospitals is the key issue of Daniela D'Alessandro's presentation at ANAM15. Teacher at Sapienza University in Rome, D'Alessandro has stressed the link between dirty or not duly cleaned HVAC systems and the rising tax of infections.

Last but not least, Vincenzo Buonomo, Dean of the Pontificia Urbaniana University in Rome, has discussed the importance of the quality of air from an ethic and juridic point of view. "Since the pandemic took place, people are sensitive to air quality levels; HVAC market companies are asked to assume a higher responsibility. An ethic approach is needed not only when acting but even before the action will be taken."

The ANAM15 Gala Dinner took place Thursday night at Spazio Novecento. Davide Bardi, voice actor, set designer, a great artist, read a monologue recalling the history of AIISA, from Giorgio Ziragachi's idea to get a few HVAC cleaning companies in an association to the first draft of AIISA bylaws. Bardi has named Air Systems Cleaning Specialists as "guardians and protectors of the air quality."

To date, AIISA has over 100 Italian member companies and more than 300 individuals certified with their ASCS.
